**Topic:** **Capital & Repair Expenditures**  
2018 (Intentions) and 2017 (Preliminary)  
Released by Statistics Canada – February 28, 2018

**Background:** Capital expenditures in non-residential construction and machinery and equipment are expected to total **\$1.3 billion** in 2018, down **17.7%** from 2017.
