**Topic:** **Capital & Repair Expenditures**  
2019 (Intentions) and 2018 (Preliminary)  
Released by Statistics Canada – February 22, 2019

**Background:** Capital expenditures in non-residential construction and machinery and equipment are expected to total **\$1.4 billion** in 2019, down **19.1%** from 2018.
