**Topic:** **Consumer Price Index (2002=100.0)**  
 December 2018  
 Released by Statistics Canada – January 18, 2019

**Background:** In December 2018, consumers in Iqaluit paid **3.5%** more than in December 2017 for the goods and services included in the Consumer Price Index basket.

The Canadian Consumer Price Index increased by **2.0%** over the same period.
