Topic: **Consumer Price Index (2002=100.0)**
November 2018
Released by Statistics Canada – December 19, 2018

Background: In November 2018, consumers in Iqaluit paid **2.4%** more than in November 2017 for the goods and services included in the Consumer Price Index basket.

The Canadian Consumer Price Index increased by **1.7%** over the same period.
