**Topic:** **Consumer Price Index (2002=100.0)**  
 September 2012  
 Released by Statistics Canada – October 19, 2012

**Background:** In September 2012, consumers in Iqaluit paid **2.0%** more than in September 2011 for the goods and services included in the Consumer Price Index basket.

By comparison, the Canadian Consumer Price Index increased by **1.2%** over the same period.
