Topic: Food Services and Drinking Places
 October 2018
 Released by Statistics Canada – December 17, 2018

Background: In Nunavut, preliminary estimates for total sales of the food services and drinking places industry for October 2018 were **\$3,255,000**. This represents an **increase of 58.1%** from October 2017.

In Canada, total sales estimates **increased 3.9%** during the same period.
