

# StatsUpdate

**Topic:** **Canada's Population Estimates**  
Second Quarter 2017 (preliminary)  
Released by Statistics Canada – September 27, 2017

**Background:** Statistics Canada estimated Nunavut's population to be **37,996** as of July 1, 2017 – an **increase of 0.9%** or **339** people from April 1, 2017.

By comparison, the population of Canada **increased** by **0.4%** over the same period.
