Topic: **Nunavut Community Population Counts**
2016 Census
Released by Statistics Canada, February 8, 2017

Background: Most communities in Nunavut saw an increase in population counts between the 2011 and 2016 Censuses. Chesterfield Inlet and Kugaaruk had the largest growth during that period. Population counts decreased in Grise Fiord, Kimmirut and Resolute Bay. With a population count of **7,740**, Iqaluit remains the most populous community, accounting for about **21%** of the population. Rankin Inlet, Arviat and Baker Lake and were the second, third and fourth largest communities in terms of population counts.
